

## Catskill Elementary Summer School for AIS Reading & Math

The Catskill Central School District Summer School Program runs Monday through Thursday from 8:00 am-12:45 pm beginning Thursday, July 1 and ending Wednesday, August 4. **On the last day of school, August 4th classes will run until 3:00 p.m.** Classes will be held at the Catskill Elementary School. Students should not arrive before 7:55 am as there is no supervision available. **Parents are expected to be prompt in picking up their children.**

A bag lunch will be provided daily at 10:45 am. The lunch program will follow the same process as the regular school year except the students will eat in their classrooms. The cost of lunch will be \$1.25. If your child received free or reduced lunch during the school year, this would apply during the summer.

Two Sessions

Session 1 July 1-July 20, 2010

Session 2 July 21-August 4, 2010

The Catskill School District will be offering a summer school program for students entering Kindergarten at the Catskill Elementary School. The main goal of the program is to provide a positive transition from Pre-School to Kindergarten. The Jumpstart Program will run from 8:00 am-12:45 pm beginning Wednesday, July 1 and ending Wednesday, August 4. Classes will be held Monday through Thursday at the Catskill Elementary School.

A bag lunch will be provided daily at 10:45 am. The lunch program will follow the same process as the regular school year except the students will eat in their classrooms. The cost of lunch will be \$1.25 or free. If your child received free or reduced lunch during the school year, this would apply during the summer.

# Catskill Elementary Summer School

## **Class Sessions**

The Summer School day will be daily from 8:00 am-12:45 pm beginning Thursday, July 1 and ending Wednesday, August 4, 2010. **On August 4th class will end at 3 p.m.** Classes will be held Monday through Thursday at the Catskill Elementary School. Students should not arrive before 7:55 am as there will be no supervision available. The program ends daily at 12:45 pm. **Parents are expected to be prompt in picking up their children.**

## **Attendance & Participation**

Attendance is a critical component of the program. All students are expected to be present each day of the season.



## **Who is Eligible?**

Students who have been enrolled in remedial reading or math during the school year or who fall below the State Reference Point on tests will be recommended to attend. Kindergarten students will be recommended by their teacher. Out of district students will not be eligible for the elementary summer school program.

## **Transportation**

Transportation will be **provided on a limited basis from centralized pickup points.** Parents will be responsible for transporting their children to and from the closest designated bus stop or Catskill Elementary School. Please note that the bus stops may not be the same as those during the school year. If your child cannot walk from the bus stop to home, it is very important that someone be available to meet your child when the bus arrives at the stop.

## **Discipline**

The Catskill School Discipline Code will be followed. Serious infractions of the Discipline Code may result in dismissal from the program.

## **How to Register**

There is no registration fee.
