

TITLE I PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT

The Board of Education believes that student achievement is directly related to parental involvement, and therefore encourages such involvement in school educational planning. As used here, the terms parent/parental includes a parent or guardian.

To assure compliance with federal Title I guidelines, the Board directs the administration to implement programs, activities and procedures to achieve parental involvement in planning, designing and implementing such programs. To this end, the district will send an annual newsletter informing parents of the reasons, objectives and methods of the program; provide training opportunities for parents to work with their children at home; convene an annual meeting for parents of participating students; and utilize such parents as volunteers or paid classroom aides. Parent notification correspondence will be provided in the language understood by the parents.

This policy will be reviewed annually by the professional staff and parents/guardians to determine the effectiveness of the parental involvement policy in increasing the participation of parents/guardians.

All such programs are intended to strengthen the relationship between home, school and student and to increase student achievement.
