LEGAL NOTICE OF  
ANNUAL PUBLIC HEARING ON THE BUDGET,  
ANNUAL MEETING, SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTION AND VOTE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Board of Education of the Catskill Central School District, Greene County, New York, will hold the Annual Public Hearing on the Budget on Tuesday, May 4, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. in the Catskill Middle School Auditorium for the presentation of the 2010-2011 budget of the Catskill Central School District and Catskill Public Library.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Annual Meeting, School District Election and Voting on Propositions of the Catskill Central School District shall be held on Tuesday, May 18, 2010, between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 9:00 P.M., when the polls will be open for the purpose of voting by voting machine.

A copy of the detailed statement of expenditures which will be required for the ensuing year for school purposes (the Budget), including attachments and tax exemption reporting form, may be obtained by any resident in the District during the fourteen (14) days immediately preceding the Annual District Meeting, except Saturday, Sunday, or holiday, at the Office of the Superintendent of Schools, 343 West Main Street, Catskill, New York, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and on any of such days from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., at each school building within the District, as well as on the District website.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the following items will be presented to the qualified voters of the Catskill Central School District at the Catskill Senior High School Gymnasium on Tuesday, May 18, 2010, when the polls will be open from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. for the purpose of voting, by voting machine:

- A. To elect four members to the Board of Education: three seats are for three year terms, from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013 and one seat is to complete an unexpired term, due to the resignation of Beverly Cotten, through June 30, 2012
- B. To vote upon the appropriation of the necessary funds to meet the estimated expenditures for the Catskill Central School District purposes for the 2010-2011 school year (the Budget) and authorizing the levy of taxes necessary to pay the same;
- C. To vote upon the appropriation of the necessary funds to meet the estimated expenditures of the Catskill Public Library for the 2010-2011 year and authorizing the levy of taxes necessary to pay the same;

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the District has walk-in voter registration and any person can register to vote with the School District from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM on Monday through Friday on days when the District Offices are open, at the District Clerk's Office, 343 West Main Street, Catskill, NY.

Any person shall be entitled to have his/her name placed upon the register provided that he/she personally appears and is known or proven to the satisfaction of the District Clerk to be then or thereafter

entitled to vote at the School District Election and Budget Vote. No person shall be entitled to vote whose name does not appear either on the register of this District or on the appropriate election district register of the Greene County Board of Elections.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the following classes of persons shall be entitled to vote at the Annual School District Election and Vote, to be held on Tuesday, May 18, 2010, without further registration:

1. Any qualified voter who has previously registered for any annual or special district meeting or election and who has voted at any annual or special district meeting or election held or conducted within the four (4) calendar years prior to the preparation of the register,
2. Any person registered with the Greene County Board of Elections who is qualified to vote at general elections, provided that they are so registered more than ten (10) days prior to the scheduled School District election.

The register will be on file in the office of the District Clerk at the Catskill Central School District Superintendent's Office located at 343 West Main Street, Catskill, New York, and will be open for inspection by any qualified voter of the District between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. on May 12, 13, 14, and 17, 2010, at the office of the District Clerk, Superintendent's Office 343 West Main Street, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 15, 2010, and at the polls on the day of the Annual District Meeting, May 18, 2010, from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that petitions for nominating candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education must be filed with the District Clerk, by 5:00 P.M. no later than the thirtieth day preceding the School Election (Monday, April 19, 2010), in the form and manner prescribed by Section 2018 of the Education Law. Such petitions must be signed by at least 25 qualified voters of the District, must state the name and residence address of the candidate and the name and residence address of each signer. Petition forms may be picked up at the office of the District Clerk during regular business hours, except Saturday, Sunday and holidays.

The order of names of candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education for appearance on the ballot will be determined by lot one day after the filing date, at 9:00 A.M. on Tuesday, April 20, 2010. The drawing will take place in the District Clerk's Office at the Superintendent's Office 343 West Main Street, Catskill.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that applications for absentee ballots may be obtained at the Office of the District Clerk located at the Office of the Superintendent of Schools, 343 West Main Street, Catskill, New York. Applications for absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days prior to the election and vote (by May 11, 2010) if the ballot is to be mailed or the day before the election (May 17, 2010) if the ballot will be picked up personally by the voter at the Office of the District Clerk. All qualified voters who meet the criteria for "permanently disabled" and are so certified by the Greene County Board of Elections will receive absentee ballots by mail. Absentee ballots must be received in the Office of the District Clerk not later than 5:00 P.M. on the day of the Election and

Vote, May 18, 2010. A list of all persons to whom absentee ballots shall have been issued will be available for inspection to qualified voters of the District at the Office of the District Clerk during regular office hours, 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM, until the day of the Annual District Election & Vote. Any qualified voter may file a written challenge of the qualifications of any person whose name appears on such list stating the reasons for the challenge.
