Coaches

Terms of Employment: Positions are for activities for the Catskill student population during the 2010-2011 school year. Stipends are pursuant to relevant collective bargaining agreement or Board authorization.

Qualifications:

1. Demonstrated knowledge of the particular activity and related experience as determined by the Board of Education
2. Ability to foster and sustain students' interest in the activity and promote skill development
3. Strong interpersonal and communication skills
4. Required Coaching certification CPR and AED training, fingerprinting and criminal background check in accordance with NYSED regulations
5. Has the ability to organize and supervise a total sports program.

Reports to: Athletic Director and Assistant Athletic Director

Goals: To instruct athletes in the fundamental skills, strategy and physical training necessary for them to realize a degree of individual and team success. At the same time, the student shall receive instruction that will lead to the formulation of moral values, pride of accomplishment, acceptable social behavior, self-discipline and self-confidence.

Performance responsibilities:

1. Responsible for sending accurate information and timely communication to players and parents concerning practices, game schedules and team requirements.
2. Responsible for communicating with parents and players to address issues or concerns about player performance or conduct.
3. Actively promotes the program and seeks student participation.
4. Attends and supervises all practices and competitions (meets, matches, games etc)
5. Ensures the safety of the students and maintains responsibility for the security of equipment and facilities.
6. Ensures completion of health exam by athletes.
7. As needed, assists with equipment inventory, ordering and management, as well as proper repair and cleaning of all district owned equipment.
8. Monitors athlete attendance, behavior, academic states, and grades.
9. Completed required state association rules exam.
10. Completes any administrative reports.
11. Models and ensures athletes exhibit positive sportsmanship.
12. Provides sequential conditioning, and appropriate skill and tactical training.
13. Exhibits positive motivation towards students, and gives appropriate attention to the maturity and readiness of athletes.
14. Has the ability to use approved first aid and CPR skills.
15. Performs other duties related to the sport as assigned.

Evaluation: Performance of this job will be evaluated annually in accordance with provisions of the Board's policy on evaluation of coaches.

Applications will be accepted until position is filled. All positions are contingent upon sufficient student participation at all times.
